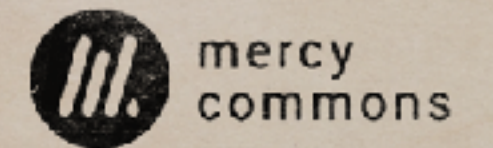
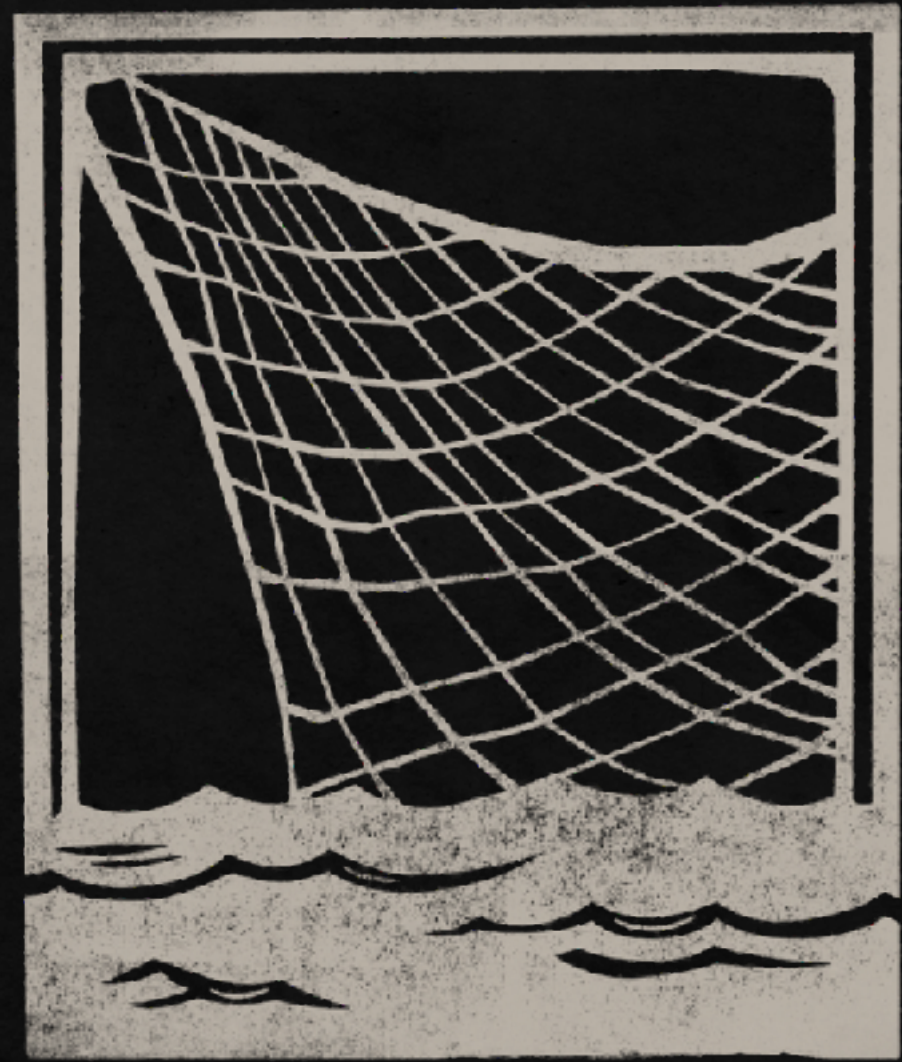

LUKE 5:1-11

¹ On one occasion, while the **crowd was pressing in** on Him to hear the word of God, He was standing by the lake of Gennesaret, [also known as Sea of Galilee] ² and He saw two boats by the lake, but the fishermen had gone out of them and were washing their nets. ³ Getting into one of the boats, **which was Simon's**, He asked him to put out a little from the land. And He **sat down and taught the people** from the boat.

LUKE 5:1-11

⁴ And when He had finished speaking, He **said to Simon,** **“Put out into the deep and let down your nets for a catch.”** ⁵ And Simon answered, “Master, we toiled all night and took nothing! But at Your word I will let down the nets.” ⁶ And when they had done this, they enclosed a large number of fish, and their **nets were breaking.** ⁷ They **signaled to their partners in the other boat** to come and help them. And they came and **filled both the boats,** so that they began to sink.

⁸ But when Simon Peter saw it, he **fell down at Jesus' knees**, saying, "**Depart from me**, for I am a **sinful man, O LORD.**" ⁹ For he and all who were with him were astonished at the catch of fish that they had taken, ¹⁰ and so also were **James and John**, sons of Zebedee, who were **partners with Simon**. And Jesus said to Simon, "**Do not be afraid; FROM NOW ON YOU WILL BE CATCHING MEN.**"

LEFT EVERYTHING AND FOLLOWED HIM.

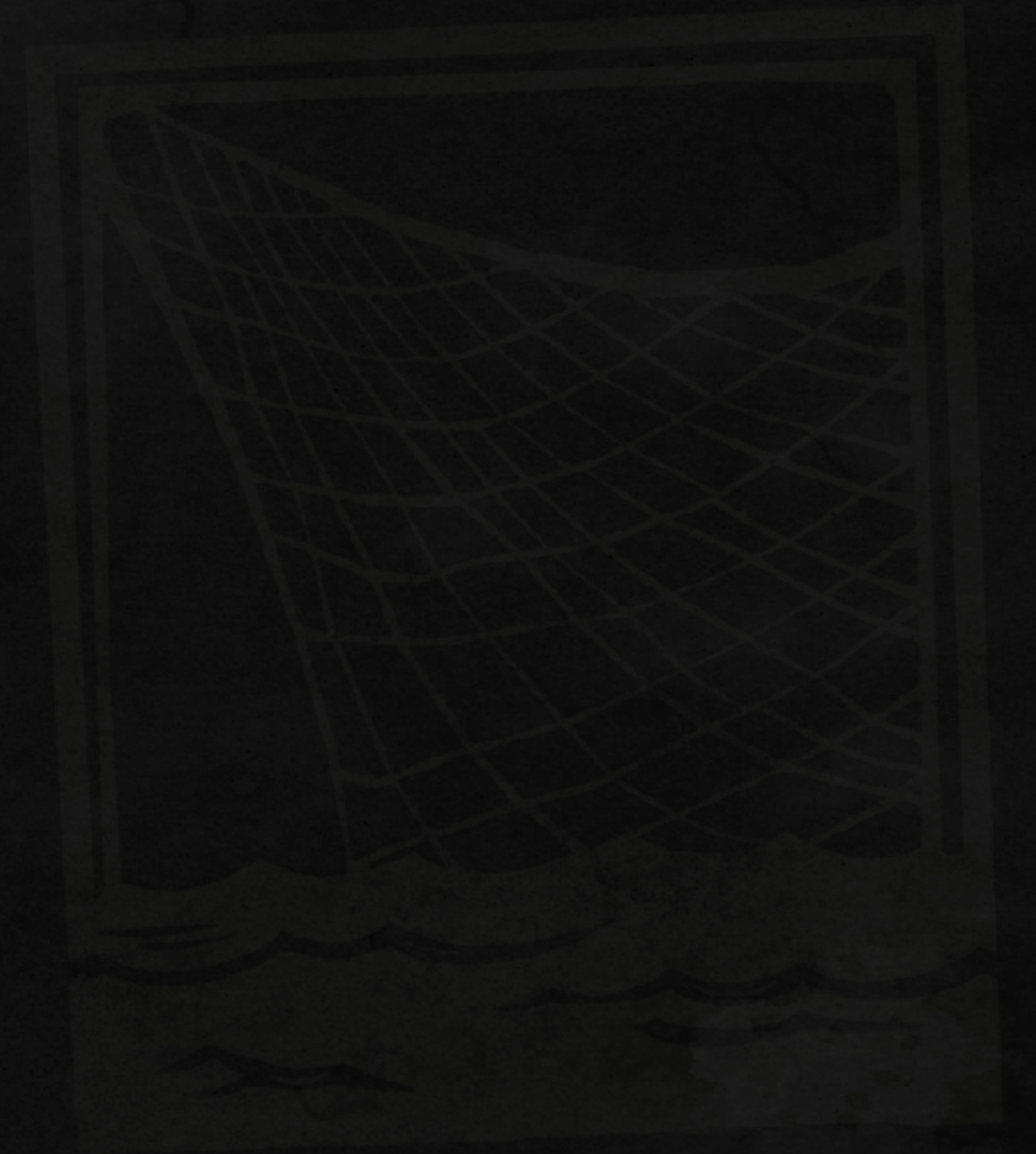
JOHN 1:40-42
